Between June and beginning December these graceful creatures migrate to the warm waters of the Indian Ocean to calve in our sheltered waters. We are able to offer you the chance of an adventure of a lifetime and do boat-based whale watching and on the same trip you will encounter many other forms of marine life such as dolphins, sharks and various types of pelagic birds.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: We launch through the surf, this means you are going to walk through the sand and into the water to get onto the boat - it is called a HIGH ENERGY LAUNCH - this makes the whale watching trips unsuitable for certain people - please read the criteria under "read more"

MORE

What to bring:

- Extra warm jacket
- Towel
- Packet of biscuits
- Seasick medication if needed
- Rubber or plastic footwear for walking into the sea

What is provided:

- Lifejackets
- Raincoats

People NOT suited for high energy whale watching trips:

- Osteoporosis
- Previous Neck or Back Injuries
- Elderly and frail clientele
- Epilepsy sufferers
- Ladies that are pregnant
- People prone to panic attacks
- Young Children
- People that are seriously overweight (apologies for this, but it is an issue on a high energy activity like a surf launch whale watching trip)

We do open-date gift vouchers that you can hand to the recipients as gifts on a special day. This allows the recipient the flexibility to make the final booking on a date that suits his/her personal schedule. This also turns the gift into a “double whammy” gift as the recipient receives the voucher on the special day and then has the anticipation of going on the adventure on a suitable date.

Our open date vouchers are valid for a period of 6 months from date of issue; this is a precaution to guard against price increases only, the value of the voucher is never lost. Should the participant not use the voucher within that time period, the value is still there, and if there has been no price increases, the recipient uses the voucher as is. If after the six months grace period there has been a price increase, the recipient will be liable to pay in the price difference only.

INTINERARY

More about the trip:

- The skipper is a specialized Marine Mammal Guide and the only holder of a legal permit to take guests on boat-based whale watching adventures around St. Lucia.
- The whale watching adventures are most popular during June to December when whale populations are at their most abundant
- The boat trip lasts 2 hours with a half hour on either side for briefing and getting to and from the launch site
- You will be transferred to the launch site in a 4X4 truck onto the beach
- On occasion a hydrophone will allow you to listen to the whales singing to each other below the waves
- Your guides will fill you in on all the interesting whale knowledge that they have gained over the years

Media Offer:

The skipper has obtained a legal filming permit MCM, granting them permission to photograph and film whales. From the time the guests meet till the adventure ends three hours later, a cameraman will be video tracking your every experience. You can purchase a personalized DVD from the Whale Shop roughly an hour after your adventure.

Please Note:

South Africa only has 9 legal boat-based whale watching permit holders of which our charter company is one. Don't have the wool pulled over your eyes for a lower price offered by a dodgy operator without a legal permit. It is your responsibility to make sure that you are taking a trip with a legal permit holder.
